Press release for September 21, 2011

Assault

On August 26, 2011 at 13:33 hours, Hilltown Police responded to CVS pharmacy, located at 700 Rt. 113 for an assault on a patron which just occurred. Investigation revealed that a female patron had been shopping in the cosmetics section of the store, when an unknown male subject approached her left side. This male subject for no known reason punched the female patron with a closed fist in the left side of her face, immediately knocking her to the floor. After getting up off the floor, the female exited the store and observed the male subject leaving in a tan colored vehicle. The vehicle registration number was obtained and the subject was identified. The victim advised that she has never had any prior contact whatsoever with the male suspect. The suspect was identified as Khasiem Jamal Carr, 28 yrs, from 200 block of South Washington Street, Telford, Pa. Carr was charged with Misdemeanor Simple Assault, and Recklessly Endangerment of another Person, and a summary count of Harassment. Store surveillance video clearly depicted this assault as a totally random and unprovoked assault.

Disorderly Conduct

On September 12, 2011 at 18:36 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Meadow Glen Apartment complex for the report of a disturbance. Investigation determined that a physical altercation had occurred between Julie Elmore, 39 yrs, from the 400 Block of East Summit Street, Telford, PA. and a female juvenile. As a result, both individuals were cited for Disorderly Conduct, and released.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol

On August 20, 2011 at 02:13 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Wawa, located at 3520 Bethlehem Pike for the report of a man slumped over the wheel, parked diagonally in front of the store. Upon investigation, the operator was identified as Corey F. Knight, 29 yrs, from the 200 block of Washington Place, Telford, Pa. Knight displayed severe signs of alcohol impairment and was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Knight was transported for a blood test which he refused. Knight was subsequently charged for Driving under the Influence of Alcohol.

On August 27, 2011 at 02:01 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Stadium North Bar, located at 1903 Bethlehem Pike for the report of vehicle crash in the parking lot. Investigation identified the driver of the vehicle as Alexis Thomas, 24 yrs, from 1000 Block of Mews Drive, Sellersville, Pa. Thomas displayed signs of alcohol impairment and was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Thomas was transported for a blood test resulting in a 0.246% BAC. Thomas was subsequently charged with Driving under the Influence of Alcohol.

Theft

On July 22, 2011 at 11:18 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the Geitz Machine Shop located at 4422 Bethlehem Pike to investigate the theft of scrap aluminum. Investigation of the local scrap dealers revealed that the very distinguishable aluminum scrap metal was sold for \$143.40 by Brian Hendrickson, 50 yrs, from the 100 Block of Reliance Rd., Souderton, PA. As a result, Hendrickson was charged with Theft of Movable Property.

On August 12, 2011 at 17:54 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, located at 1515 Bethlehem Pike to investigate the theft of store merchandise. Upon investigation and examination of store surveillance video it was determined that John Moore, 38 yrs, from 1500 Block of Franklin St. Kulpsville, Pa and his accomplice, Brenda O'Donnell, 42 yrs, from the same address had taken \$190.68 in store merchandise to the customer service desk, and returned the item without having purchased it. They received \$190.68 in a gift card for this fraudulent return. As a result, Moore was charged with Misdemeanor Theft by Deception, Retail Theft, and Criminal Conspiracy. O'Donnell was charged with criminal conspiracy to those enumerated offenses.

Retail Theft

On August 19, 2011 at 14:31 hours, Hilltown Police responded to Walmart, located at 1515 Bethlehem Pike for a retail theft that just occurred. Investigation revealed that two female actors had worked in concert in taking various store merchandise. Further investigation identified both females as Jennifer Louise Hernandez, 29 yrs, from the 700 Block of Shaw Avenue, Lansdale, Pa. and Alizandria Alverio, 29 yrs, from the 200 block of East Chestnut St. Souderton, Pa. Investigation revealed Hernandez when fleeing the loss prevention personnel used her child as a shield, and drove off with her child still unsecured in her lap. A criminal History revealed that Hernandez was charged with 6 prior retail thefts. Hernandez was subsequently charged with Felony Retail Theft, Criminal Conspiracy, Endangering The Welfare of Children, and Recklessly Endangering Another Person. Alverio was also charged with Felony Criminal Conspiracy, and Retail Theft.
