Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol

On November 26, 2011 at 01:43 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the 200 block of Rickert Road for the report of a single vehicle traffic accident. Through investigation it was determined that a vehicle driven by Jeffrey Michael Hardy, 23 yrs, from the 1000 block of Hilltown Pike, Line Lexington, Pa had driven off the roadway and into a ditch. Hardy displayed signs of alcohol impairment, and subsequently failed field sobriety testing. Hardy was taken into custody and transported for a blood test. The result of the blood test was a 0.203% BAC. Hardy was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On November 14, 2011 at 14:55 hours, Hilltown Police clocked a vehicle traveling southbound on Rt. 309 at Bergey Road at the rate of 76 mph in the 55 MPH zone. The vehicle was stopped at Rt. #309 and Church Road and was driven by Andrew V. Blank, 42 yrs, from 100 block of Prairie Court, Quakertown, Pa. Blank displayed indications of alcohol impairment, failed field sobriety testing, and was taken into custody for DUI. Blank was subsequently transported for a blood test which he refused. Blank was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Maximum Speed Limits.

On October 29, 2011 at 19:05 hours, Hilltown Police responded to the area of Bethlehem Pike and Spur Road for the report of a two vehicle accident, with one of the involved vehicles having fled the scene, southbound on Rt. 309. Investigation determined that a green Pontiac had been traveling northbound on Bethlehem Pike and had impacted another northbound vehicle. After impact the green vehicle operated by a female driver fled southbound on Rt. 309. The disabled green Pontiac was located a short distance away on Unionville Pike. The operator of the Pontiac was identified as Celia Loraine Diaz, 51 yrs, from 300 block of North Main Street Telford, Pa. Diaz displayed signs of alcohol impairment and was taken into custody for DUI, and transported for a blood test. The result of the blood test was a 0.160% BAC. Diaz was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Accidents Involving Damage to Attended Vehicle or Property, and Duty to Give Information and Render Aid.

On October 13, 2011 at 21:13 hours, Hilltown Police while on routine patrol observed a vehicle accelerate at a high rate of speed from the intersection of Rt. 113 and Bethlehem Pike, and weave erratically over the painted roadway lines as it traveled northbound on Rt. 113. The vehicle was stopped on Keystone Drive and found to be operated by James M. Hey, 39 yrs, from 400 block of Schultz Rd. Sellersville, Pa. Hey displayed signs of alcohol impairment and was administered field sobriety tests which he failed. Hey was taken into custody for DUI and transported for a blood test. The blood test resulted in a 0.145% BAC. Hey was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Registration and Certificate of Title Required.

On November 21, 2011 at 21:52 hours, Hilltown Police had occasion to clock a Ford pick-up truck traveling northbound on Rt. 309 at Rt. 113 at the rate of 75 mph in the 55 MPH zone. This vehicle was stopped and the driver was identified as John D. Reynolds, 42 yrs, from 400 block of Pinecrest Road, East Norriton, Pa. Reynolds displayed signs of alcohol impairment and failed field sobriety testing. Reynolds was taken into custody and was transported for a blood test. The result of the blood test was a 0.116% BAC. Reynolds was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/or a Controlled Substance, and Maximum Speed Limits.

On October 22, 2011 at 00:56 hours, Hilltown Police observed a vehicle weaving erratically on Rt. 309 northbound at Unionville Pike. The vehicle was stopped and determined to be operated by David P. Deily, 40 yrs, from 4000 Block of Axe Handle Road, Quakertown, Pa. Deily displayed signs of alcohol impairment and subsequently failed several field sobriety tests. Deily was taken into custody for DUI and transported for a blood test. The results of Deily's blood test was a 0.243% BAC. Deily was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.

On December 13, 2011 at 01:13 hours, Hilltown Police observed a vehicle weaving erratically on Rt. 309 near Mill road. This vehicle was stopped and found to be operated by Tyler T. Pritchard, 41 yrs, from 200 block of Heatherfield Drive, Souderton, Pa. Pritchard displayed signs of alcohol impairment and failed field sobriety testing. Pritchard was taken into custody for DUI and transported for a blood test. Pritchard refused the test. Pritchard was subsequently charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving on Roadways Laned for Traffic.
