

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance will be considered by the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors at a regular meeting to be held on Saturday, October 16, 1965, at 9:00 o'clock A.M. in the Hilltown Township Building on Pennsylvania Route 113 west of Silverdale.

ORDINANCE NO. 65-4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISTURBING THE PEACE
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

The Township of Hilltown hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person disturbing the peace within Hilltown Township shall be guilty of a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Disturbing the peace is hereby defined as any act, word or conduct causing or tending to cause a disturbance of the peace and good order of the Township; or causing or tending to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of the Township or users of the Township thoroughfares; or making any loud, boisterous or unseemingly noise or disturbance; or fighting or quarreling or inciting others to fight or quarrel; or the public use of obscene or indecent language; or the loafing or loitering or congregating upon any public streets or alleys or public grounds of the Township of Hilltown, to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street or alley or being lawfully upon any public grounds of the Township whereby the public peace is broken or disturbed or the traveling public annoyed.

The act of congregating or loitering on private property by persons who are neither business invitees nor guests in such a manner as to inconvenience other persons who are business invitees or guests is also defined as disturbing the peace and is hereby declared to be unlawful.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall in proceedings instituted before any justice of the peace, pay a penalty to the township of not more than \$25.00, together with the costs of the proceedings.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 60-3, adopted December 3, 1960, is hereby repealed.
