ORDINANCE NO. 68-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, ADOPTED DECEMBER 2, 1967, BY REDEFINING THE TERM "SUBDIVISION".

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 216 of the Hilltown Township subdivision regulations, adopted December 2, 1967, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 216. The term 'Subdivision' means the division or redivision of a lot, tract or parcel of land by any means into two or more lots, tracts, parcels or other divisions of land including changes in existing lot lines for the purpose, whether immediate or future, of lease, transfer of ownership or building or lot development: Provided, however, That the division of land for agricultural purposes into parcels of more than ten acres, not involving any new street or easement of access, shall be exempted."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1969.
