

ORDINANCE NO. 93-6

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON BROAD STREET, FROM THE TERMINUS OF HILLTOWN PIKE TO THE INTERSECTION OF UPPER CHURCH ROAD.

THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, upon the recommendation of the Hilltown Township Police Department who has observed the traffic patterns on Broad Street within Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and pursuant to appropriate engineering and traffic studies and investigation, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning described to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code "P.M.V.C.", 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act Number 81, as amended. (75 P.S. 1000 et seq., as now enforced or hereafter amended).

Section 2. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Broad Street in Hilltown Township, from its terminus at Hilltown Pike to the intersection of Upper Church Road is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs reducing the speed limits of the aforesaid Broad Street as set forth herein, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the P.M.V.C.

Section 4. Any person violating the maximum speed limit as set forth herein shall be prosecuted under the P.M.V.C., and shall be subject to the fines and penalties therein set forth.

Section 5. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, and amendments thereof are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
