ORDINANCE NO. 92-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 68-1 AND PROVIDING FOR RECOGNITION OF ALL AUTHORITIES PROVIDING WATER SERVICE UNDER THE MUNICIPALITY AUTHORITIES ACT OF 1945, AS AMENDED, WITHIN HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP

Preamble

Pursuant to Section 702 of the Second Class Township Code and the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township hereby enacts and ordains:

SECTION ONE - PURPOSE

This Ordinance is designed to repeal the exclusivity of water service provisions contained in Ordinance No. 68-1 whereby certain municipal corporations were granted exclusive rights of public water service within Hilltown Township. This Ordinance is further designed to recognize all Municipal Authorities providing public water service within Hilltown Township which are properly organized under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, 53 P.S. 301 et seq. as hereafter amended by the General Assembly of Pennsylvania.

SECTION TWO - PRIORITY OF PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS

The Hilltown Township Water and Sewer Authority shall have priority in providing public water service to those areas of the Township within which it can reasonably and economically extend water service to Township residents. All other Municipal Authorities operating within the corporate boundaries of Hilltown Township may extend public water service within the Township upon written approval by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to those rights retained by the Township under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended, and the Second Class Township Code.

SECTION THREE - REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. The following ordinance is specifically repealed:

SECTION FOUR - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective on 1992.
