

ORDINANCE NO. 88-8

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON NAROTHYN ROAD, FROM DIAMOND STREET WESTWARD TO THE TERMINUS OF NAROTHYN ROAD AT SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD.

THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, upon the recommendation of the Hilltown Township Police Force who has observed the traffic patters on Narothyn Road within Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and pursuant to appropriate engineering and traffic studies and investigation, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning described to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act Number 81, as amended. (75 P.S. 1000 et seq., as now enforced or hereafter amended).

Section 2. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Narothyn Road in Hilltown Township, from its intersection with Diamond Street to its terminus at Schoolhouse Road is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs reducing the speed on the aforesaid Narothyn Road from fifty-five (55) miles per hour to thirty-five (35) miles per hour, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

Section 4. Any person violating the maximum speed limit as set forth herein shall be prosecuted under the Vehicle Code, and shall be subject to the fines and penalties therein set forth.

Section 5. All Ordinances, parts or Ordinances, and amendments thereof are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the foregoing Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
