

ORDINANCE NO. 86- 7

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON BROAD STREET (T413), FROM UPPER CHURCH ROAD (T354) EASTWARD TO THE TERMINUS OF BROAD STREET AT ROUTE 313 (SR 313).

THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, upon the recommendation of the Hilltown Township Police Force who has observed the traffic patterns on Broad Street within Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and pursuant to appropriate traffic studies, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

Section 1. Words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall have the meaning described to them in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 1976, June 17, P.L. 162, Act Number 81, as amended. (75 P.S. 1000 et seq., as now enforced or hereafter amended).

Section 2. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of forty-five (45) miles per hour on Broad Street in Hilltown Township, from its intersection with Upper Church Road to its terminus at Route 313 is hereby prohibited.

Section 3. The proper authorities of the Township are directed to erect official signs reducing the speed on the aforesaid Broad Street from fifty-five (55) miles per hour to forty-five (45) miles per hour, and to do so in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

Section 4. Any person violating the maximum speed limit as set forth herein shall be prosecuted under the Vehicle Code, and shall be subject to the fines and penalties herein set forth.

Section 5. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, and amendments thereof are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the foregoing Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
