

ORDINANCE NO. 80.2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE WEIGHT OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON KEYSTONE DRIVE BRIDGE OVER A BRANCH OF COUNTY LINE CREEK, APPROXIMATELY SEVEN HUNDRED (700) FEET NORTH OF CHURCH ROAD IN HILTOWN TOWNSHIP (P-336), AND TELEGRAPH HILL ROAD BRIDGE OVER AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF THE PERKIOMAN CREEK LOCATED JUST SOUTH OF SOUTH PERKASIE ROAD (T-154) ON TELEGRAPH HILL ROAD (T-346) IN HILTOWN TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle or tractor, or tractor and tractor-trailer combination, having a gross weight in excess of that herein respectfully prescribed, upon any of the following bridges or portions thereof:

1. Keystone Drive Bridge(T-336) (located over a tributary of County Line Creek, approximately 600 ft. North of Church Rd. LR-09112)	Entire length of bridge	Ten (10) tons

<u>BRIDGE</u>	<u>PORTION</u>	<u>MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT</u>
2. Telegraph Hill Rd. Bridge (T-346) (located over an unnamed tributary of the Perkioman Creek, approx. just south of South Perkasie Road T-154)	Entire length of bridge	Ten (10) tons

SECTION 2.

Signs shall be erected and maintained designating the above-stated restrictions at each end of that portion of any highway or bridge restricted as provided in Section 1 of this Ordinance and in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. Sections 4903 (a,c,d).

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the powers granted to townships of the second class, particularly those found in 75 Pa. C.S.A. Sections 4903 as amended.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following enactment. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced in accordance with 75 Pa. C.S.A. Sections 4902 (e).


SECTION 5.

This Ordinance is designed specifically to protect those portions of the township's roadways and bridges which may be seriously damaged by the use or the movement of heavy vehicles. It is further the purpose of this Ordinance to prevent the creation of a safety hazard by the prohibition of the movement of heavy vehicles upon certain roadways and bridges within Hilltown


Township.
