ORDINANCE NO. 29-6

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MILES PER HOUR ON GREEN STREET IN HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP FROM HILLTOWN PIKE (LR 919) THROUGH TO THE BOROUGH OF SILVERDALE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of 45 miles per hour (forty-five) on Green Street (T340) from Hilltown Pike (LR 919) to the Borough of Silverdale is prohibited.

SECTION 2. The proper authorities of the Township are hereby directed to erect official signs restricting the speed as aforesaid in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the maximum speed limit set forth hereof shall be prosecuted under the pertinent Section of the Vehicle Code, Act of April 29, 1959, P.L. 58, as amended, and shall be subject to the fines and penalties therein set forth.
