

ORDINANCE NO. 78 - 7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, HAVING TO DO WITH TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Supervisors deem it appropriate to provide for the traffic control by establishing this Ordinance which will prohibit or restrict the use of Township roadways to particular classes of vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. No person shall operate a truck or bus (except for local deliveries) on those highways or portions of highways designated and described in Section 2. of this Ordinance. The definition of truck and bus is as defined in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, Act No. 81 Section 102.

Section 2. The operation of a truck or bus is excluded from the following highways:

Section 3. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the powers granted to townships of the second class, particularly that found in Section 601 (7)(13) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code Act No. 81.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall not be effective until official traffic-control devices giving notice of the traffic regulations of this ordinance are erected upon or at the entrance to the highway or part thereof affected as may be most appropriate.

Section 5. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars plus costs of prosecution and in default of the payment of the fine and costs, to imprisonment for a number of days equal to one day for each Ten (\$10.00) Dollars of the unpaid balance of the fine and costs.


Section 6. This Ordinance is designed specifically to protect those portions of the Township roadways which may be seriously damaged by the use or the movement of heavy vehicles. It is further the purpose of this ordinance to prevent the creation of a safety hazard by prohibiting the movement of large vehicles upon certain roadways within Hilltown Township.
