ORDINANCE NO. 25.7

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON MIDDLE ROAD AT THAT POINT WHERE MIDDLE ROAD LEAVES DUBLIN BOROUGH TO THE POINT WHERE IT INTERSECTS WITH TOWNSHIP ROAD 413 ALSO KNOWN AS BROAD STREET.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Hilltown, County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the same meaning ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force, or as hereafter amended.

SECTION 2. The operation of any motor vehicle in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Middle Road in Hilltown Township between the point where Middle Road exits from Dublin Borough to where it, as Township Road 415, intersects with Township Road 413, also known as Broad Street.

SECTION 3. The proper authorities of the Township are hereby directed to erect official signs restricting the speed as aforesaid in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 4. Any person violating the maximum speed limit as set forth in Section 2 hereof shall be prosecuted under the pertinent section of the Vehicle Code, Act of April 29, 1959, P.L. 58, as amended, shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10) and costs

of prosecution and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
