A. POLICE VEHICLE BIDS: The Board of Supervisors discussed recent bids for a 1995 marked police vehicle. Due to the fact that A & T Chevrolet, one of two bidders, could not supply this vehicle and because the bid from Faulkner Ford was quoted with three major specification changes, Chief Egly recommended both bids be denied.

Motion was made by Supervisor Bennington, seconded by Supervisor Fox, and carried unanimously to deny the bids for the 1995 marked police vehicle, and to utilize the State Contract bid.

B. PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE: The Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission members continued their discussion of the proposed Zoning Ordinance.
