Receipts amounted to \$240.85. bids for stone were rec'd from D.D. Dentine, Tolichon Quarry and from General Crushed Stone Co. D.D. Dentine was the lowest price. and therefore got the order for stone 2700 Tons 3A ~~750~~ at 161 per ton 700 ton No 2 @ 1.70 and 400 ton No 3 at 1.80 per ton. The 1941 Road Tax Duplicate amounts to \$5940.66. and with warrant was handed to the Collector. Stone approval and County aid application were received from State Highway Dept. and after signed were sent to the vendor and several Departments. The meeting adjourned to meet the first Monday in May with a bal. in Treasury of \$10,960.16.
