Resolution was made and sent to Highway Dept. for approval to expend our entire allocation under Act 10-A for construction of Township road No 336-1.7 mi of 3" Penetration ^{macadam} at estimated cost of \$15,000.00. Form 965, Report of State Fund Expenditures was sent to Highway Dept. Mr. Endrean was present and helpful. Purchase orders for approval were prepared for " " for purchase of oil 50,000 gal more or less at 8 1/2 cents per gal. The meeting adjourned to meet the first Monday in March with Bal of \$9,555.05.

Receipts were \$186.32. All bids recd for road tar & asphalt were opened. The lowest tar bid was 11¢ per gal. All tar bids were rejected. Bids on asphalt were as follows. Interstate Asphalt Co 8½¢ per gal. Asphalt Industries 9¢ per gal and Texas Co 12¢ per gal. The Interstate Asphalt Co's bid was accepted and bids were mailed to Highway Dept at Ardmore with purchase orders for 50,000 gal. more or less @ 8½¢ per gal. A resolution was passed and sent to Highway Dept for approval to expend entire allocation of State Funds for 1941 under Act 10-A for construction of Township road No 336 - 1.7 mi of 3" Penetration Macadam at an estimated cost of \$15,000.00. Mr Charles Erdman was present and helped prepare form 965 and sent to Highway Dept. The meeting adjourned to meet the first Monday in March with Bal in treasury of \$9555.05
