Bal in the treasury at close of meeting was \$11,985.21. A resolution was passed by the board to solicit bids for oil for resurfacing improved roads in town in amount of 25,000 gallons more or less as required to protect said roads. Bids were sent to Pierre Mather, Phila. Victory tax deducted amount to \$6.80. Bids to be in on or before June 7 1943. The meeting adjourned to meet the first Monday in June.
