Said accounts were audited and approved by the auditors. The balance in the treasury from 1942 to 11,220.41. The auditors, Wm D Frey, Wm D Hill and Jeannette Woodroffe met two days to audit and are entitled to \$18.00 each. A copy of organization of the new Board was mailed to Highway Dept, Harrisburg as follows, Pres. Wm K Rice & Pres. Elmer H. High. Sec & Treas Abram K. Yothers. A resolution was passed for the appointment of Wm K. Rice as Foreman to expend State Funds received from Harrisburg in the amount of \$5334.00 for 1943. A street light was laid by supervisors for 1943 at .002 mills, and secretary authorized to prepare said duplicate tax to be collected in February. The meeting adjourned to meet the first day of February.
