The Supervisors of Hilltown held their monthly meeting this day with all members present. passed and paid the following bills amounting to \$1267.69. Receipts amounted to \$12.86. Bids for oil & stone for construction of road no 386. Bids were received from D. D. Derstine, Polickon Quarries & Bituminous Service Co for stone. D. D. Derstine, being lowest bidder got contract to furnish 4000 tons of stone, more or less at 2.20 for 3A - 2.20 for 2 B, and 2.50 for 1 B. 1.90 for grit. Bids for oil were received from Bituminous Service Co. & Interstate Asphalt Co. Interstate being lowest bidder got contract to furnish 25,000 gal & deliver more or less as needed at 16.4 per gal. The meeting adjourned with \$2416.14 Bal in treasury to meet the first Monday in May.
