

Hilltown Township Supervisors' Meeting-12/27/83

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Vincent Pischl. The treasurer's report was read by Mrs. Gutekunst and approved by Mary Lockard and seconded by Robert Grunmeier. The bills in the amount of \$7,855.90 were approved for payment by Mary Lockard and seconded by Robert Grunmeier. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.

Resolution 83-37 providing an easement across the Brickajlik subdivision for the purpose of emergency maintenance of the retention basin located on Lot #2 was passed by a motion made by Mary Lockard and seconded by Bob Grunmeier. Resolution 83-38-accepting the Deed of Dedication for the road widening of Route 113 and Diamond St. on the Brickajlik subdivision was passed by a motion made by Mary Lockard and seconded by Bob Grunmeier.

A sketch plan of the subdivision of the Franklin Rice property was presented to the supervisors by Mr. Wynn. The plan was denied because it did not meet with the preliminary requirements but the concept of the plan was approved by a motion made by Mary Lockard and seconded by Bob Grunmeier. This approval is subject to the conditions listed in the minutes of the Hilltown Township Planning Commission minutes of 12-19-83.

The subdivision plan of Helen Berdell was approved by a motion made by Bob Grunmeier and seconded by Mary Lockard. This approval is subject to the compliance to the items mentioned in the engineer's letter- items 5 and 10 being waived.

The budget for the year, 1984 was presented in the amount of \$1,005,400.00- \$802,000.00-General Fund, \$133,600.00-State Funds, \$69,800 Federal Revenue Funds. Motion made by Mary Lockard and seconded by Bob Grunmeier to pass the budget.

Mr. Don Ownes expressed the desire that all the town watch signs be erected early in 1984. All but 3 of the first list of signs have been erected. Don also introduced Dick Johnson, Vice President of the Town Watch.

Question asked about the C. D. Moyer problem- nothing new.

Mr. Frank Rice said the culvert pipe at Welcome House Road and Dublin Road is rusted out so there is flooding at this intersection. Also mention was made of the growth of underbrush and weeds at the intersection of Rickert Road and Route 152.

Mr. Pischl reminded everyone that the reorganization of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors would be held on January 3, 1984 at 7:30 P.M.

Mr. Pischl read a letter of commendation signed by the supervisors to Mrs. Gutekunst on her retirement.

There being no other business, meeting was adjourned.
