The Interstate Asphalt Co was low @ 16.5 per gal. 35,000 gals. more or less. Form 968 for const. of roads was made up and sent to Ord. Mre and County Aid Forms were made up for building 1.5 mi 16 ft DP1 macadam road at estimated cost of \$8,000. Contracts were made up and sent to successful bidders. Mr. Goddard, contractor of Traffic Light erection furnished bond in amount of contract price and received his check on deposit. The meeting adjourned to next Monday in June.
