The Supervisors of Hilltown held their monthly meeting this day with all members present, passed and paid the following bills amounting to \$553.88. Receipts for March were \$1233.78. Bids were received for Traffic Light at intersection of 1/13 + 308 only one bid was received and contracted for by W. O. Godshall at cost of \$1,026.24. A resolution was passed unanimously to construct 1.7 miles of road with 3 in Pavement Macadam 16 ft wide. it being advertised for bids for materials bids to be furnished the sec. on or before Apr 29 at 5 P.M. County Aid papers were sent to County Commissioners for aid for traffic light expenditure. A contract was also mailed to Top Engineer at Allentown with request for necessary forms for construction approvals. The meeting adjourned to meet May 1st at 6 o'clock.
