

Auditors Meeting

The Auditors of Hilltown met this day with The Supervisors all present to audit Coll. & Treasurers accts for the year 1950. The results follow
Total receipts and Bal. were \$42268.91. and Total expenses \$33100.08. and Bal in the Treasury of \$9168.88. or a Trup bal. of 7707.88 + State Fund Bal of \$146.12.
Street Light acct was audited and approved. The Auditors agreed to raise Supervisors pay from 95 to 100 per hr for labor and from 4 to 5 for attending monthly meetings. The Supervisors raised the pay for their employees from 85 to 90 per hour. The names & addresses of the 1951 board of Supervisors was mailed to the Dept of Highways at Harrisburg and State Fund Report was mailed to Dept of Highways at Harrisburg.
The auditors were not finished on their reports of the audit and will meet some later date to finish report. The Supervisors adjourned to meet the first Monday in Feb.
