

Hilltown Township Supervisors' Meeting

September 26, 1977

The meeting was called to order by the Vice-Chairman, Vincent Pischl. The treasurer's report was read by Mrs. Gutekunst and approved by Ed Wentz and seconded by Vincent Pischl. The bills as presented were approved for payment by Ed Wentz and seconded by Vince Pischl.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A correction was made changing the name of the owner of Barney's Auto parts. A letter was received from Wm. G. Major Associates that Neshaminy Water Resources Authority and the County of Bucks have both passed resolutions approving the preparation of a preliminary report and design for adjustments to Church Road. A letter was received from Edwin Angstadt, attorney for Mr. Lamelza, owner of the "The Village", explaining his position on the drainage problem at their development on Broad St. Mr. Wilson received a copy of this letter and Mr. Leister is following on this matter as well.

Mr. Samuel Bistline, Jr. asked the supervisors whether he would need to apply for a variance to conduct a furniture stripping and refinishing business on a property located at the intersection of Route 152 and South Perkasio Road. He was advised that this would be necessary.

Mr. David Nemecek of Broad St. Hilltown Township was in to the meeting inquiring about the curbing being constructed in front of his property which he bought from Robert Carter. Mr. Carter is responsible for having this curbing done. Mrs. Gutekunst will check with Mr. Carter.

Mr. Wentz made inquiries as to the status of the drainage problem and situation in front of the J. & B. Property on Schoolhouse Road. Mrs. Gutekunst will check with Jim Leister and have him call Ed Wentz.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by Vince Pischl and seconded by Ed Wentz. The police report for the month of August, 1977 was read by Mrs. Gutekunst.

Letters were received from Steve Stein of Community Development advising that Hilltown Township's share of the next three years' grant would be \$136,600.00. Application should be made for this money with an eligible project by November 15th. Tabled until the next meeting.

Notice received that the semi-annual convention of the Bucks County Association of Township Officials-"Legislators Night" will be held on October 12th at the Warwick Fire Hall. Mrs. Gutekunst will send in the reservations so she should be notified as to who is going, etc.

The Sewer Authority submitted an application for Township Road Occupancy which was approved by the supervisors. Mr. Frankenfield reviewed the permit and Mrs. Gutekunst will issue same.

The board of supervisors recessed in to executive session on a personnel matter from 7:45 P.M. to 8:15 P.M.
