

Hilltown Twp. Pa.Jan 18 1958Auditors Meeting

The Auditors of Hilltown Twp held their annual meeting this day, with the Supervisors to audit the Treasurer's and Collector of Taxes accounts for 1957 with all members present. The Supervisors finally adopted the (peddling or soliciting) ordinance to be in effect Jan 15 1959 which requires solicitors (with a few exceptions) to obtain a permit to canvass. The Twp. Permits to be obtained from I. D. & Justice Twp. Police. The Board of Supervisors agreed to change meetings for 1959 as follows. Meetings to be held on the first and third Saturday of each month. Starting Feb 7. to be held at the Supervisors Office in the Twp Building at 9 A.M. on Rt 113 west of Silosdale. The sec was requested to advertise in the News-Herald time & place of meeting, and was so advertised on Jan 15. 1959 for 1 week. A bid for purchase of a Gosssett by Civil Defense Director was accepted by a motion by Mr. Agin and seconded by Paul Frankfield. said Gosssett to be purchased and delivered within 30 days. The Twp. seal was purchased and approved. This day a motion was made & seconded to raise the Treas. Bond from \$20,000.00 to \$50,000.00. The Board started drawing up a budget for 1959 tentatively but was not finished on account of tax levy not yet decided upon. The Supr. Contemplate making tax levy for the Twp. and Budget at the next monthly meeting namely on Feb 7 1959. The Auditors are this day Jan 20 not through with the auditing, but expect to be finished by Feb 1 1959. The Auditors turned in their Report on Jan 31. as follows. a bal in the Treasury from 1958 of \$12,486.88 in the General Fund and \$4252.64 in the State Fund or a total in the Treasury of \$16,739.44. The State Fund Report was made up and after signed by the Supervisors is to be mailed to the State Highway Dept for approval and the Highway Budget is to be made up and also sent to the Dept of Int. Affairs. A motion was made by Paul Frankfield & seconded by Emer High to re-enact a resolution. Approved Feb 7 1958 - to authorize the Treasurer to deposit all the Township money in deposit in the Bucks County Bank and Trust Co. as in former years. Abram K. Gathers sec.
