The Supervisors of Hilltown held their semi-monthly meeting this day with all members present, passed + paid the foregoing bills amounting to \$2362.71 from Gen Fund and \$1475.23 from State Fund or a total of \$3837.94. Receipts amounted to \$16863.63 leaving a bal. in the Treasury of \$15981.25 in the Gen. Fund and \$8339.24 in State Fund. Total amt. in the Treas now is \$24320.49.

Mr Budd Mounce was present at the meeting to tender his resignation as a member of the Twp Industrial Committee, and was reluctantly accepted. Mr Ed Shuck, Sec. of the Planning Com. was also present to discuss matters pertinent to Planning for the Township. The board members resolved to forward a letter to Mr Mounce of appreciation of his services as a member of the Industrial Committee of the Township and a letter was sent to Mr Mounce thanking him for his services rendered while serving on said committee. The meeting adjourned to meet on Sept 17 at 9 A.M. at Twp Office.

Receipts amounted to \$97.96 - Bal in Treasury is \$14,959.71 in Gen Fund + \$4241.08 in S.F. or a total of \$19200.79. A letter was rec. by chairman of the Board from Leiford Dussell that he must ^{resign} from the Industrial Committee as he is moving out of Hilltown Twp in the near future. ^(Resignation was accepted and) A motion was made and seconded to request the Sec. to forward a letter in behalf of the Board of Supervisors in Thanks and appreciation for time and services rendered to the Twp while serving on said committee. ^(and to commend a job of the Supr. Board) Such letter was mailed to Mr Dussell on Sept 20, 1960. Upon a motion + seconded the chairman appointed Albert Agin ^{Police} as supervisor to the Township Police, effective immediately. A going meeting to be held at the Twp Office on Sept 30 at 7.30 P.M. upon a petition by a taxpayer to consider + change zoning on 309 from Residential to Commercial, and is being advertised. The meeting adjourned to meet on Friday evening ^{Sept 30} a 7.30 P.M.

Sept 30, 1960

A special meeting was held at 8:00 P.M. on Sept 30th at the request of ^{Wilbur Japp} ~~Wm Hart Rufe III~~ atty for ~~Wm Hart Rufe III~~ to have zoning of Twp changed as follows. On east side of Rt 307 from Rt 113 To Rt 428 (Cherry Lane) a district of approx 3/4 mi. from residential to Highway Commercial and having no opposition it was so changed by a motion Paul Frankfield, and seconded by Elmer Hockman, supervisors of Hilltown Twp. Mr. Agias was not present. It was proposed to get ^{enlarge} ~~map~~ the size and was so passed by the Supr. Board and amendment R 30 To Highway Commercial (also proposed to enlarge) signs along the highway from 1 square foot to 3 square feet and ^{was} favored by the Sec of the Planning Board of the Twp. A deposit for meeting expense & change in zoning was presented by Atty Rufe in the amount of \$60.00. The Bal if any to be refunded.
