

MEETING OF THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, WAS HELD THIS 7TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1972 AT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING, LOCATED ON ROUTE 113 & DIAMOND STREET, SILVERDALE, PA 18962.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER MR. FRANKENFIELD, PRESENT WERE OUR NEW SUPERVISOR SUPERVISORS MR. HARTSHORNE, AND MR. MOYER.

OTHERS PRESENT WERE MR. GUBELMAN, MR. HEIDRICH, MR. MOORE, MR. BROWNING MR. NEVELLS, MR. MININGER, MR. BOOSE AND REPORTERS LORRAINE CAMPBELL, INTELL- GENCER, MR. CRESSMAN, CALL - CHRONICLE AND MR. MITCHELL NORTH PENN REPORTER.

MEETING OPENED WITH THE READING OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING HELD DECEMBER 8, 1972. A MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE TO ACCEPT MINUTES AS READ. MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD.

MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE TO PAY ALL BILLS. MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD. SUPERVISORS SIGNED THE FINAL SUBDIVISION PLANS, FOR RUFUS HAGER 2 LOTS LOCATED ON QUARRY ROAD, BRANDIS TRACT, HIGHLAND PARK ROAD 3 LOTS, AND THE WALTER SHADE TRACT, LOCATED ON CENTRAL AVENUE 2 LOTS.

SUPERVISORS RAN A LETTER, FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO THE PERKASIE BOROUGH AUTHORITY, RESERVING 300,000 GAL PER DAY SEWAGE TREATMENT CAPACITY IF AND WHEN AGREEMENTS ARE SIGNED.

SIGNED APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT, FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES TO ERECT A BRIDGE ACROSS MILL CREEK ON RELIANCE ROAD \$28,000 WAS BUDGETED FOR THIS PROJECT.

ROLAND FRETZ WAS APPOINTED, AS A MEMBER OF THE ZONING HEARING BOARD TO FILL THE UNEPIRED TERM OF HENRY NYCE. THIS TERM EXPIRES 1973.

OUR FINAL BUDGET APPROVED FOR THE YEAR 1972, WAS \$281,880.28cts AND \$35,000 WAS BUDGETED FOR LIQUID FUELS FUND.

OUR FINAL RECEIPTS FOR THE YEAR 1971, AMOUNTED TO \$261,880.59 CTS. AND OUR EXPENDITURES WERE \$254,423.24CTS, LIQUID FUELS ALLOCATION OF \$41,253.38 CTS.

RECEIVED FROM TITUS G. MOYER, TAX COLLECTOR, FOR REAL ESTATE & PER CAPITA THE AMOUNT OF \$1,131.58 CTS, FROM ED MININGER FOR BLDG & ZONING PERMIT \$206.00.

MR. HEIDRICH ASKED FOR A REPORT FOR THE MEETING WITH MR. BOYLE, FROM THE BUCKS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, WITH THE PLANNING COMMISSION, MR. HARTSHORNE, STATE THAT IT WAS SATISFACTORY AND INFORMATIVE, THE WAY MR. STATED HOW THEIR FEASIBILITY TESTS WERE MADE.

MR. MININGER BLDG INSPECTOR, ASKED APPROVAL FOR A PERMIT FEE LIST TO BE USED FOR TOWNHOUSES - MULTI FAMILY HOMES. WE FEEL WE SHOULD CONSULT WITH MR. COWAN TOWNSHIP ENGINEER BEFORE ADOPTING THE FEE SCHEDULE.

MR. HEIDRICH MENTIONED TO THE SUPERVISORS, THAT THERE WERE A LOT OF CARS PARKED AROUND THE MAGER PROPERTY, AND THAT NEW PEOPLE WERE ~~MOVING~~ RENTING APARTMENTS, AND IF WE COULD DO ANYTHING ABOUT THE SITUATION. READ LETTERS WE RECEIVED FROM OUR ATTORNEY IN REFERENCE TO THE PROBLEMS THERE. SECRETARY WAS TO INQUIRE FROM OUR ATTORNEY WHO IS RECEIVING THE RENTS. THE ATTORNEY STATED THAT THE RENTS WERE TO BE PAID TO THE COURTS, UNTIL THESE PEOPLE MOVE OUT. BUT IF NEW PEOPLE MOVED IN IT DID NOT APPLY. THE TOWNSHIP HAS A MOVE IN ORDINANCE, BUT CHIEF BOOSE CAN NOT ISSUE A PERMIT IF THE BUILDING DOES NOT MEET TOWNSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

MR. COWAN, IN A LETTER TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, IS GOING TO SEND US A ~~DESCRIPTION~~ DESCRIPTION OF REGION I AREA, WHICH THE TOWNSHIP RELINQUISHED TO TELFORD BOROUGH AUTHORITY TO SEWER.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, TABLED A PROPOSAL BY BUSH BUILDERS, THAT THEY WERE IN RECEIPT OF A LETTER FROM THE HONORABLE WILLIAM A BARRETT U.S. CONGRESSMAN PLEDGING HIS SUPPORT IN FINDING MONEY TO FINANCE THEIR PROPOSED SEWER CONNECTION TO HATFIELD.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS ON A MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE, TO ADJOURN MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD. MEETING ADJOURNED 11:45)0 ' CLOCK A.M.
