

MEETING OF THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, WAS HELD THIS 15 TH DAY OF APRIL, 1972. AT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING, LOCATED ON ROUTE II3 AND DIAMOND STREET. SILVERDALE, PA.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER, AT (0'CLOCK A.M. BY THE CHAIRMAN MR. FRANKENFIELD. WITH ALL SUPERVISORS PRESENT .

MEETING OPENED WITH THE READING OF THE MINUTES, OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING, A MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE TO ACCEPT MINUTES AS READ. MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD. MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE TO PAY ALL BILLS, MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD.

PRESENT WERE CINDY O'CONNEL, NANCY ATKINS, STUDENTS, AND MEMBERS OF THE GIRL SCOUT CADETTE TROOP #184 HILLTOWN, PA . THEY WERE WORKING ON MR GOVERNMENT BADGE. OTHERS PRESENT WERE MRS O'CONNELL, CHIEF BOOSE, FIRE CHIEF WALTERS, MR. GUBELMAN, MR, HEIDRICH, MR. BROWNING, MR. FINKLENSTEIN, MR. COONEM,

WE RECEIVED FROM TITUS COLLECTIONS \$10,260.64 CTS , REAL ESTATE TAX FOR 1972 AND \$448.41 CTS FOR THE YEAR 1971. FROM THE RECORDER OF DEEDS OFFICE, THE AMOUNT OF \$1,983.93 CTS REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX.

MR. MININGER , ZONING AND BLDG INSPECTOR, SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, A BLDG COST ESTIMATE FOR MULTI-FAMILY AND TOWN HOUSE PERMITS OF \$70.00 A UNIT. SUPERVISORS WILL GIVE THIS FURTHER STUDY.

SECRETARY TO INFORM OUR SOLICITOR, THAT THE SUPERVISORS WISH TO HAVE AN AMENDMENT, ADDED TO OUR BUILDING CODE, THE BASIC BUILDING CODE, THIS CODE HAS PROVISIONS FOR FIRE WALLS.

MR. HARTSHORNE, MENTIONED THAT HE HAD BEEN APPROCHED ON THE STATUS OF THE HORN QUARRY. HE THEN CONSULTED OUR SOLICITOR, AND WAS INFORMED THAT WHEN AN APPEAL IS FILED , THEY MAY OPERATE.

A RESOLUTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE, THAT WE HAVE ROAD INSPECTION, MOTION SECONDED BY MR FRANKENFIELD.

A REQUEST FROM THE BUCKS COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION, NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION, FOR FLOOD PLAIN INFORMATION, FOR THE DELAWARE VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION, SO THAT THEY WOULD BE ELIGIBLE FOR FLOOD PLAIN GRANT. SECRETARY TO CONSULT WITH MR. COWAN TOWNSHIP ENGINEER IF HE HAD MAPS OR SLIDES PERTAINING TO HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP.

THEIR WAS SOME DISCUSSION ON , ON FIRE PROTECTION AT THE NEW GRANTS STORE AT COUNTY LINE & ROUTE II3. FIRE CHIEF WALTERS, MENTIONED THAT THEIR SHOULD BE AT LEAST (5) FIRE HYDRANTS IN THE AREA, MR. HARTSHORNE MENTIONED THAT HE WAS INFORMED , THAT THEY HAD A VERY LOW RATING, SECRETARY WAS TO INFORM THE SHOPPING CENTER OF FIRE CHIEF WALTERS RECOMMENDATIONS. UPON INVESTIGATION, THERE ARE FIVE HYDRANTS IN THE AREA, MR. BOCHERS MAJOR OF THE NORTH FERN WATER PLANT , IN A NEWS RELEASE STATED THAT THE FIRE PROTECTION IN THIS AREA IS OF THE BEST, WITH A CAPACITY OF 2,000 GALLON RESERVE AND A STAND PIPE HOLDING 3 AND 1/2 MILLION GALLON OF WATER.
