The Treasurers Report was presented & accepted as read. A letter from Mr. William Raudenbush, requesting the Board to accept his Resignation from the "Industrial Development Comm. Due to his moving from the Township in the near future, Bill, felt his duty to notify the Board, so an appointment could be made to fill his unexpired term. His Resignation was accepted and at the same time the Board appointed Mr. John Roedel, of Hilltown Pike, Hilltown, Pa. To fill this vacancy.

A Resolution was passed adopting the one designating the Bucks County Historical Commission as the "Tourist Promotion Agency" for the County of Bucks. This Resolution being passed by the Board after the Bucks County Commissioners had passed a similar Resolution.

A Resolution for the appointment of the Aord Sub-Division was presented. ~~Upon~~ After studying the plans, the Board decided to approve same & adopted the Resolution.

Mr. Peters, presented his Zoning Officer's Report for the month of October, showing a steady increase in building in the Township.

OF THE TOWNSHIP OF *Hilltown* CONCURRING
IN THE RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COM-
MISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BUCKS, PENN-
SYLVANIA, DESIGNATING THE BUCKS COUNTY
HISTORICAL COMMISSION AS THE TOURIST
PROMOTION AGENCY FOR THE COUNTY OF BUCKS
IN ALL MATTERS RELEVANT TO AND FOR ALL
PURPOSES OF THE TOURIST PROMOTION LAW.

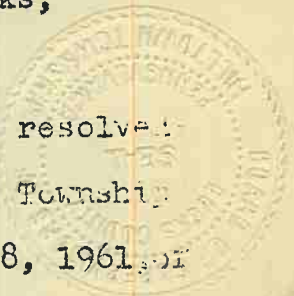
WHEREAS, by Resolution dated August 8, 1961, the
Board of Commissioners of the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania has
designated the Bucks County Historical Commission as the Tourist
Promotion Agency to represent the County of Bucks in all matters
relevant to and for all purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law; and

WHEREAS, The Bucks County Historical Commission may
only act as the Tourist Promotion Agency for the County of Bucks
upon concurrence in the above stated Resolution of the Board of
Commissioners of the County of Bucks by the governing bodies of
cities, boroughs, towns, townships, within the county having in
the aggregate over fifty per centum of the population of said
county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of
Hilltown desires that the Bucks County Historical Commission
act as the Tourist Promotion Agency for the County of Bucks,
Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved:

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the Township
of HILLTOWN concurs in the Resolution dated August 8, 1961.
