The Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors, was held this day, with all members present, Mr. Frankeneield, Presiding.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved. The Treasurers Report was presented and approved. Bills amounting to \$4,863.75 from the State funds and \$938.51 from the General Fund was presented and ordered paid.

At a previous meeting the Police had been instructed to inspect all junk yards monthly and to submit to the Board, a written report of their findings. At this meeting both Officer Derstine, & Officer Tyson, presented their reports which was very good. These reports showed the findings of the officers and also showed warnings given to those operators who have been negligent with their junk yards.

Mr. Enslow, a taxpayer, was present requesting information on his tax reduction on his sub-division, and also to get information on his standing if he would take this reduction. The Chairman, advised him that when he put his land back to farm land from his present sub-division, he then would have to make new plans later, if he would decide to sub-divide said land. He now holds a sub-division plan, that had been approved prior to the adoption of the zoning ordinance, which lot sizes are 25,000 + 30,000 sq feet. If he forecits this plan he now holds if at a later date would want to sub-divide, he would have to have 50,000 sq feet per lot according to the adopted ordinance.

Mr. Agin, presented a problem on Broad Street between, Hilltown & Callowhill Street, a bad curve which should have some warning shown was discussed. The Chairman, recommended a curve sign, which was approved by all, sign to be erected soon. The Tax Collector made his report, showing approx. 90% of current taxes, collected to date.
