The regular monthly meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of supervisors was called to order by the Chairman Mr. Frankfield, with all members present. The minutes were ^{read} approved, passed and paid. The following bills included in Treas. report. Mrs. Everett Barrett, requested a permit for the use of fust rope (firecrackers) against birds in his orchard. Motion by Mr. Frankfield, seconded by Mr. Workman, in favor of said Permit. Permit was then issued. The Secy received a letter from Lawyer Grim, requesting a voluntary permit for the red cross Cellitaw, for Hilltown Township. After discussing the matter, it was decided that the group did not have to issue a permit. A phone call to Mr. Grim, verified ruling of the board. Mr. James Smithers, Tax collector for Hilltown Township was present ~~to~~ and submitted his monthly report, which was accepted by the board. Mr. Ritchie, Township Engineer was present to present to the board the full particulars and specification for the construction of the new proposed bridge on Hillcrest Ave. Mr. Ritchie was instructed to prepare all matter for advertisement so that bids could be opened at a date no later than 1st of May. Mr. Thomas, Chairman of the industrial development Comm. presented a couple of maps from which he & his Comm. are working very hard. He explained that his Comm. has met recently with some industrial developers and had acquired lots of knowledge for future use. After opening and studying the stone bids it was moved & seconded that ~~D. D. Duvine~~ & Swartz be awarded the stone contract with a contract price of a delivered avg of \$1.72 Ton. Radler & Sharp was at the same time awarded the oil contracts for .17 gal del. There being no further business, meeting was adjourned to meet on the 18th of Mar.
