Reorganization Meeting.

The Supervisors of Halltown Prop held their Annual Meeting this day with all members present. Passed and paid the foregoing bills and to \$4891.10. Receipts amounted to \$4467.54. The Supervisors upon motion raised the Zoning Officer Fee from \$1.60 to \$1.85 per hour for the year 1961. as Zoning Officer and Park Inspector, John Alden was appointed on planning Com. to succeed his expired term for 5 yrs to 1966. Mr Henry Wyce was appointed for the next 3 yrs as a member of the Board of Adjustments. New officers appointed for Industrial Development Com. are Wm Raudenbush, Geo Eckhardt, Charles Morgan, Roland Dittweiler & James Thomas. The Reorganization Meeting was held and elected & appointed the following officers for Chairman Paul Frankensfield Vice Chairman Elmer S Hockman and upon motion by Mr Hockman & seconded by Mr Frankensfield appointed Albert T Ligin as Sec-Treas for 1961. Appointed also were Detective Smith & Inspectors Ferguson, Wm B Ritchie and for part time Police J. D. Densline & Linus Lyson and it was proposed a change for Police Work in 1961, namely to present to the Board of Supervisors complaint sheet in duplicate accurate Report and arrest record in monthly Reports.

The Supervisors adjourned with approximately \$17,700.00 Bal for 1960. subject to Auditors Report who were requested to meet on Jan 14th at 2 A.M. at the Prop Office.

A Resolution was read and approved, naming the "Bucks County Bank & Trust" as depository for the coming year. It was decided that the meeting would stay the same as last year being the 1st & 3rd Sat of each month at 9:00 am. (ent)

Mr. Frankfield, approached the board with a problem with labor concerning hourly pay scale. After some discussion the following scales was sent as a resolution to the auditors for approval. Laborers, 1.60 per hour. operators 1.75-70 1.85, Roadmaster \$ 2.10, Supervisor 1.85, Zoning Officer 1.85, Police officers 1.70.

Before appointing the part time police, Mr. Agin explained a system for the police to record complaints & then follow same, along with a report for accidents and a report of daily log work. He felt that this will bring a monthly report to the Board of Supervisors as to the various problem of the police. The board accepted the format, and then appointed L. D. Berstene and Leroy Lyson as part time police officers.

Meeting was adjourned with approximately \$ 17,200.00 Bal for 1960, subject to Auditor report who was requested to meet on Jan 14th, 9. AM at the City Bldg.
