

MEETING WAS HELD WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18, 1971 AT 2. O'CLOCK P.M. WITH
MR. EDWIN B. HERSHEY, LEGAL DIVISION OF THE GENERAL STATE AUTHORITY.
LT DAVID CAPOZZOLI. STATE POLICE . SGT GEO FRID STATE POLICE AND CHIEF BOOSE
BLAIR BOOSE ARTHUR D. FRETZ SAMUEL Y. MOYER, THEODORE KOHL. AND SUPER-
VISOR MR. FRANKENFIELD AND MR. MOYER.

MR. HERSHEY OF THE GENERAL AUTHORITY, STATED THAT THEY WISH TO PURCHASE
A TRACT OF LAND , LOCATED ON ROUTE 113 AND ROUTE 313, FOR A STATE POLICE
STATION AND BARRACKS AND A DRIVER TRAINING STATION.

BUT THEY WANTED TO BE SURE THAT THIS COULD BE REZONED BY THE SUPERVISORS,
AND IF THEY WOULD BE WILLING TO REZONE.

THEY ALSO WANTED TO BE SURE THAT PUBLIC SEWER, WOULD BE AVAILABLE. AND
THEY WOULD BE WILLING TO BUILD THEIR OWN SEWER LINE IF NECESSARY. BUT
IN THAT EVENT ONLY THEY WOULD HAVE USE OF THE LINE. BUT IF THE BOARD
WANTED IT TO BE PUBLIC , THEN THEY WOULD CONTRIBUTE A FAIR SHARE TOWARD
THE BUILDING OF THE LINE.

THIS IS TO BE A COMBINED STATE POLICE BARRACKS, AND DRIVER TRAINING, TO
COVER THE COMBINED AREA , NOW COVERED BY THE QUAKERTOWN AND DOYLESTOWN
STATE POLICE STATIONS.

THEY REQUESTED OF THE SUPERVISORS, A LETTER FROM HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP STAT-
ING THAT THEY WISH TO REZONE LAND THAT THE GENERAL STATE AUTHORITY WISHES
TO PURCHASE. THEY DO NOT WISH TO HAVE THIS REZONED UNTIL THEY HAVE TAKEN
TITLE TO THE PROPERTY.

SUPERVISORS WILL GIVE THEM A LETTER STATING THAT WE WISH TO REZONE THIS
TRACT OF LAND FROM RESIDENTIAL - AGRICULTURE TO HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL.
