SIGNED AGREEMENT WITH SELLERSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE , FIRE PROTECTION. HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP'S CONTRIBUTION \$500.00 DOLLARS.

SIGNED RESOLUTION NUMBER 71-4. TRANSFERRING FROM BUDGETED FUND 4.12 TRAFFIC \$4,000.00 DOLLARS , TO BUDGETED FUND 1.1.06 ENGINEERING.
