

MINUTES

March 6, 1971

The meeting of the Hilltown Township Supervisors was held this 6th day of March, 1971, at the Township Building, Diamond St. and Route 113, Silverdale, Pa.

The Chairman, Mr. Hockman, called the meeting ^{to} order, by asking for the reading of the minutes by the Secretary, Mr. Moyer. The minutes were accepted as read on a motion by Mr. Frankenfield, and seconded by Mr. Hockman.

Mr. Frankenfield made a motion to pay all bills and Mr. Hockman made the seconding motion.

Visitors were Mr. Gubelman, Mr. Heidrich, Mr. Mohr, Mr. Watts, president of the Line Lexington Fire Co., Mr. Walters, Chief of the Line Lexington Fire Co., Mr. Owen Kidd, Free Press reporter and Mr. Bus Cressman, New-Herald and Allentown Morning Call reporter.

The Supervisors were invited to a ground breaking ceremony scheduled for Monday, March 8, 1971, at a tract on Clearview Road and Cherry Lane, by the North Penn Water Authority.

The Dept. of Transportation notified us that our liquid fuels allotment for 1971 will be \$41,253.38; \$10,313.45 must be used for new construction.

Mr. Edward Mininger, the zoning officer, forwarded \$607.20 for building, zoning and pipe and sign permits.

The Supervisors signed contracts for Loder & Sharp, for bituminous materials, and Farm & Home Oil Co. for gasoline.

Our building inspector, Mr. Mininger, notified us that he had mailed Cease and Desist orders to Alfred Miley, Quarry Rd.; and to Harold Fisher, Church Rd., for zoning ordinance violation of Section 1301, Article XVI, Section 1601, of the Hilltown Township Zoning Ordinance, Appeal No. 7005 and 7006, before the Zoning Hearing Board.

We received from Mr. Boyd, owner of the former Alderfer Junk Yard, \$100 for the license fee for the year 1971.

Mr. Hendricks, a resident of Rickert Rd, stated there was considerable buring on Green St. and Fairhill Rd. He was informed this would be investigated.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Mr. Hockman, and seconded by Mr. Frankenfield, at 10:30 A.M.
