

MINUTES

Jan. 9, 1971

The meeting of the Hilltown Township Supervisors was held January 9, 1971, at the Township Building, located on Route 113 and Diamond St., Silverdale, Pa.

The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by the Chairman, Mr. Hockman. He requested the minutes be read of the previous meeting, held Dec. 20, 1970. On a motion by Mr. Frankenfield, the minutes were accepted as read, motion seconded by Mr. Hockman.

A motion by Mr. Frankenfield and seconded by Mr. Hockman, was in approval of paying all bills.

Visitors were Mr. Gubleman, Mr. Heidrich, Mrs. Dorothy Smith, Mr. Stover, Mr. Dalion, Intelligencer reporter, Mr. Cressman for the News-Herald and the Morning Call of Allentown.

The Supervisors signed final plans for Howard Hunsberger, located on Broad St., 7 lots; and Dorothy Ryan, located on Diamond St. and Hilltown Pike, 2 lots.

A letter was received from our solicitor, stating that modular homes are allowed under our ordinance, as they have all the requirements as single homes; trailers are allowed if they build a home within 2 (two) years.

We received a letter from the Bucks County Park Board, stating they would like to meet with the Supervisors Board. We decided we were not interested at the present time; we answered their questionnaire.

Raymond Bassett, director of the Board of Assessment, notified us that William R & Julia Davidson had withdrawn their assessment appeal.

We were notified by the Dept. of Transportation, that they will hold a meeting in the Township Building, Jan. 25, 1971, for ^{re-~~location~~} discussions of bridge on L. R. 09088, Section IIs.

In reference to the case of Zukow vs. Hilltown Township, we were informed by a letter from our solicitors that our liability coverage is under Harleysville Insurance Co.

There being no further business, on a motion by Mr. Hockman and seconded by Mr. Frankenfield, the meeting adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
