

the semi-monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was held this day with all members present, Mr. Frankenfield, presiding the minutes from the previous meeting were read, a motion by Mr. Hockman, seconded - Mr. Frankenfield minutes were accepted. The Treasurer gave his report which is filed on following page. Mr. Yoder, Chairman of the Township Planning Committee was present requesting the signatures of the supervisors on sub-division plans for Mr. Mafle (lots 1-2-34) and Mr. Deremer (lots 1-2-3-4-5-7-8) (lot 6-15 farm + bldg) after reviewing the plans, Mr. Agin moved & Mr. Hockman seconded motion to accept plans, both sub-division plans were then signed. ~~the~~ The Amusement Tax Ordinance which had been advertised as required was read and then opened for discussion, there being none, a motion by Mr. Frankenfield, seconded by Mr. Agin, ordinance was then adopted. Mr. Felber, of Skunk Hollow Road attended requesting permission to build a bridge across the creek to gain access to his lot, Mr. Frankenfield informed Mr. Felber, the Board has no jurisdiction on the water-ways, and that he should contact the Dept of Forestry & Waters. A letter from the Board of Dublin, was read, inviting the Board members to attend "Neighbor Night", which is a part of Dublin's 50th. Anniv. Celebration. A letter from the Sellersville Fire Co. requesting a portion of the Foreign Fire Ins. monies, there being a difference of opinion on this money Mr. Agin is to contact Mr. Muntz and get a decision. But the Board feels if this money can be shared with other Fire Companies. then all (7) Companies should share ~~the~~ ^{BUT} share per their service to the Township. A letter from "Aggregate Equipment Inc", stating their desire to purchase the property now owned by Mr. Karpinski & to operate a quarry, they also stated that Mr. Karpinski had made a large investment for a crusher & a shovel (\$50,000). Mr. Agin, instructed Officer Derstine to check this property and mail his report to
