Mr. Warren, representing "Hilco" Homes, was present requesting permission to erect 3 sample homes on Keystone Drive. The Board discussed this project with Mr. Warren & suggested he build a road down thru his property in case he should like to sell any or all of these homes at a future date. Mr. Warren, related this suggestion & upon leaving said he would contact his superiors and make this suggestion known. Mr. Mayer, was present requesting the Board sign his sub-division Plan #2. After inspecting the plans, Mr. Mayer, was referred to the Township Planning Committee & Mr. Cowen, the Township Engineer, for more details on streets, drainage & storm culverts.
