The Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors, was held this day with all members present. Mr. Frankenfield, Presiding. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Bills amounting to \$1534.41 were approved for payment from the General Funds. Mr. Agin presented his monthly financial statement which was approved. The correspondence was read by the secretary of which no action at present was taken. Mr. Frankenfield, questioned the secretary on the decision of Mr. Moore's junk yard. The secretary reported a letter had been mailed to Mr. Moore, giving him 10 days in which to obtain his current & delinquent licenses. Mr. George W. Boyce, was present, requesting a change in zoning along Route 313, outside of Dublin Boro, after listening to Mr. Boyce's reasons, the chairman, suggested he contact Mr. Yoder, the chairman of the planning Comm. for a decision. Messrs. Chas & Paul Schmidt, were in attendance to complain about the zoning change for Mr. Chaney & also complained about water & drainage conditions along their road. It was suggested a meeting of the complainants & the supervisors with the Township Engineer to be held when or as soon as possible. Mr. Cowen, the Township Engineer presented his report, that was requested by the Board, on the bridge to be reconstructed this year. Mr. Cowen reported the cost of a steel deck was about \$1755.00 including handrails and a concrete construction of handrails about \$1475.00 plus labor on each proposal. No decision was made until further studying this program.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned to meet March 17-1962 - 9:00 AM at the Township office Route 113, West of Silverdale, Pa.
