The Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was held this day, with all members present. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Frankfield. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved. Bills amounting to \$1847.89 were read & approved for payment. Mr. Peters, reported that upon his request the signs at the business place of Mr. Smith, (Pa. Dutch Restaurant) are being removed to meet the requirements of the zoning ordinance. Mr. Barr, a taxpayer, who had received a letter from the police dept about the accumulation of junk on his property was present to explain his position on this matter, after discussing the facts with the Board, he then claimed he would clean up before the next inspection in March. Mr. DUBIAK, also was present to explain why he could not & would not take out a junk yd. license, his reason being (he claims) that the junk belonged to his deceased brother & they could not touch same until his estate was settled. A decision on this problem was to be handed down at the next meeting. Reports from the Police were read & accepted, along with reports from Mr. Peters, zoning officer & Park Inspector, James Smithers, passed tax collector, & the Industrial development Board. The Secretary read the correspondence with one letter being very important news. This was the decision of the Bucks County Court on the case of "Moore vs. Hilltown Twp." The decision was that the junk yard ord. was upheld. Mr. Hockman, suggested, the Secretary should eliminate printing proposals in their entirety when advertising in the paper. He ~~felt~~ feels the cost is too great, & we could save some money in this way.
