Bills amounting to \$6,360.94 from the general fund
were read - approved on a motion - Heckman, seconded -
Frankfield - motion carried.

Mrs Haefler, brought a complaint against Mr. Goodhall
for dumping junk in the field next to his property, junk
consisted of a burial coffin, tin cans, blocks, bricks
steel, etc, the Board discussed with Mrs Haefler +
Mr Goodhall the problem as presented by both parties.
Mr Heckman, suggested Mr. Goodhall clean up as soon as
possible, which he agreed to do.

Letter from Bucks County Planning Comm. was read.
in answer to request by the Board to locate original Ordinance
Vacating T. Road. 360. + Terms of sale of property. Letter was
referred to Mr. Montney for decision.

Letter from Audubon School Board, requesting the Board
help them in an effort to get Police protection for school children
crossing County line from school to athletic field. No decision.

Letter from Bucks County Industrial development was
tabled awaiting new Budget.

A Resolution was adopted authorizing the use of
act 78, 1963, permitting 2nd class Twp's to request assessment
of new construction, completed after the receipt of the
Tax Duplicate from the Bucks County Bd of assessment.
