The Regular Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Helltown Township Board of Supervisors was held this day, Mr. Hackman Presiding.

Those attending were Supervisors Lynn Hackman, Frankfield, Tax Collector Mr. Rosenberger - Tax Payer Mr. Theo. Yeakel.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read - Approved.

Bills Amounting to \$1119.34 From the general fund were read - approved for payment.

Mr. Rosenberger - presented a program of updating the Tax Bills to meet the same dates as the School Board for payment of current taxes. The Board strongly opposed this as it would delay the Construction Program 30 or more days. Mr. Hackman explained that the Board of Supervisors's Fiscal year was from Jan 1 - Dec 31, whereas the School Board Fiscal year was from Sept 1 - June 30th. So the Board could not agree to this change in tax policy.

Mr. Yeakel - Merchant - Reliance Rd - complained that people & cars were using his parking lot as a street to enter onto Rt 309. - The matter was discussed at length whereas Mr. Yeakel was informed the Board could not do anything for him, but suggested he erect "No Through" signs to help eliminate this problem.
