**Route 313 Public Sewer Extension – Resolution for Plan Revision**

A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Hilltown Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania:

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act”, as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Hilltown Township, via the Hilltown Township Water and Sewer Authority, has prepared a Component 3M to amend its Official Sewage Facilities Plan, which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of Hilltown Township, and the alternative of choice to be implemented is public sewer facilities in this area. The key implementation activities/dates include the completion of the public sewer force main extension within the area of amendment within six months of the receipt of approval of the proposed Plan Amendment and receipt of all applicable approvals and permits to commence construction.

WHEREAS, Hilltown Township finds that the Facility Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Hilltown Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the “Official Plan” of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
