A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OWNERSHIP, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF LED-ENHANCED SOLAR POWERED R1-1 STOP SIGNS AND W2-1 INTERSECTION WARNING SIGNS FOR THE INTERSECTION OF SR 113 AND MINSI TRAIL THAT ARE TO BE PURCHASED AND INSTALLED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION


WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (“Penn DOT”) has agreed to purchase and install LED-Enhanced Solar Powered R1-1 Stop Signs on Minsi Trail at its intersection with SR 113 and W2-1 Intersection Warning Signs on SR 113 on the approach to the Minsi Trail intersection.


WHEREAS, Penn DOT has agreed to install these traffic control devices as an interim traffic safety improvement in advance of the construction of a roundabout at said intersection.


WHEREAS, a Resolution accepting the ownership, operation and maintenance of said traffic control devices on behalf of Hilltown Township (the “Township”) is required before Penn DOT agrees to purchase and install said equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 23rd day of January 2023, that the Board of Supervisors hereby agrees to accept the ownership, operation and maintenance of the proposed traffic control devices to be installed at or approaching the SR 113 and Minsi Trail intersection.


