Residential Re-Sale Occupancy

Hilltown Township Code Enforcement Department <u>does NOT</u> require <u>Residential</u> Re-Sale Occupancy inspections, or new Certificate of Occupancy at time of re-sale of a <u>residential property</u>.

Hilltown Township Code Enforcement Department has no requirements for a Residential Re-sale Inspection of a legally existing dwelling, no matter how long it may (or may not) have been unoccupied. It makes no difference if the house is owner occupied or a rental.

Any new or altered dwelling **does** require a Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (UCC).

<u>However</u>- The Hilltown Police Department does require 'Move-In' and 'Move-Out' Permits; these permits do not require a fee, nor do either involve an inspection of the premises. Applications for the 'Move-In and Move-Out Permits' may be downloaded from the Hilltown Police Department's website here: https://www.hilltown.org/departments/police/documents/

This letter may be printed out and supplied to lenders a verification that there is no requirement for a <u>Residential</u> Re-Sale Certificate of Occupancy or 'U & O' Certificate.
