A Message from your Zoning Department

Keeping Chickens and Livestock in Hilltown: Key Zoning Rules

Hilltown Township requires a zoning permit for any resident who wishes to keep chickens, poultry, horses, or other livestock on a residential property. The Township's zoning ordinance allows these animals only on lots with a minimum of three acres, and the number of animals permitted increases only as additional full acres are added. All barns, coops, and shelters must meet required setbacks—typically 50 feet from property lines and roads and 100 feet from neighboring homes—to help protect surrounding properties from noise, odor, and stormwater impacts. These standards ensure that small-scale, residential agricultural uses remain compatible with nearby homes and maintain the overall character of the community.

Residents considering keeping animals should review Section 160-23.I.17 of the Hilltown Township Zoning Ordinance, available at www.hilltown.org, for the full list of requirements, definitions, and restrictions. Please reach out to the Building and Zoning Office for any questions you may have regarding residential accessory agriculture, or any development or use questions you may have.

A Message from your Public Works Director

The Hilltown Township Public Works Department will, as always, have a focus on road maintenance and improvement. Projects include, Single Application Chip Seal and/or Polymer Modified Fog seal on sections of road such as Fairhill Rd, W Creamery Rd, Frontier Rd and Welcome House Rd. In addition, we will be conducting in house paving on Rickert Rd and Telegraph Rd. Patch paving will be performed on numerous roads throughout the township. Various storm water projects will also begin including a large box culvert on E Creamery Rd along with multiple storm water pipes and inlet boxes.

With the snow melting and spring sports around the corner, baseball diamonds will be cleaned up and restored with fresh infield mix. The soccer and baseball fields will be cut weekly and lined as needed. Road mowing will also take place on a daily basis to increase field of view and keep back encroaching vegetation. Open Space and field mowing will also be performed as needed throughout the Township.

In the Spring the Township is excited to be hosting our 3rd annual Operation Legacy to support The Travis Manion Foundation at the Fairhill Rd Park. We look forward to providing our residents of Hilltown Township with continual exceptional service as always. A Message from your Chief of Police

The Hilltown Township Police Department started work towards accreditation through the Pennsylvania Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission over two years ago. Accreditation verifies that the Department meets the professional standards that are established by the commission. The process verifies that the Department's facility and policies meet the standards. Proofs must be shown to verify compliance. In January of 2026, the Department had its initial on-site accreditation assessment and by all accounts it went very well. The Pennsylvania Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission is expected to consider the Department's accreditation status at their April 23rd meeting. If the Department is approved as an accredited agency, it is good for three years, but the process is ongoing throughout that three-year period. In fact, the work on the next accreditation cycle has already started. This process has been an ongoing professional commitment by the Police Department, Township Manager and Board of Supervisors.

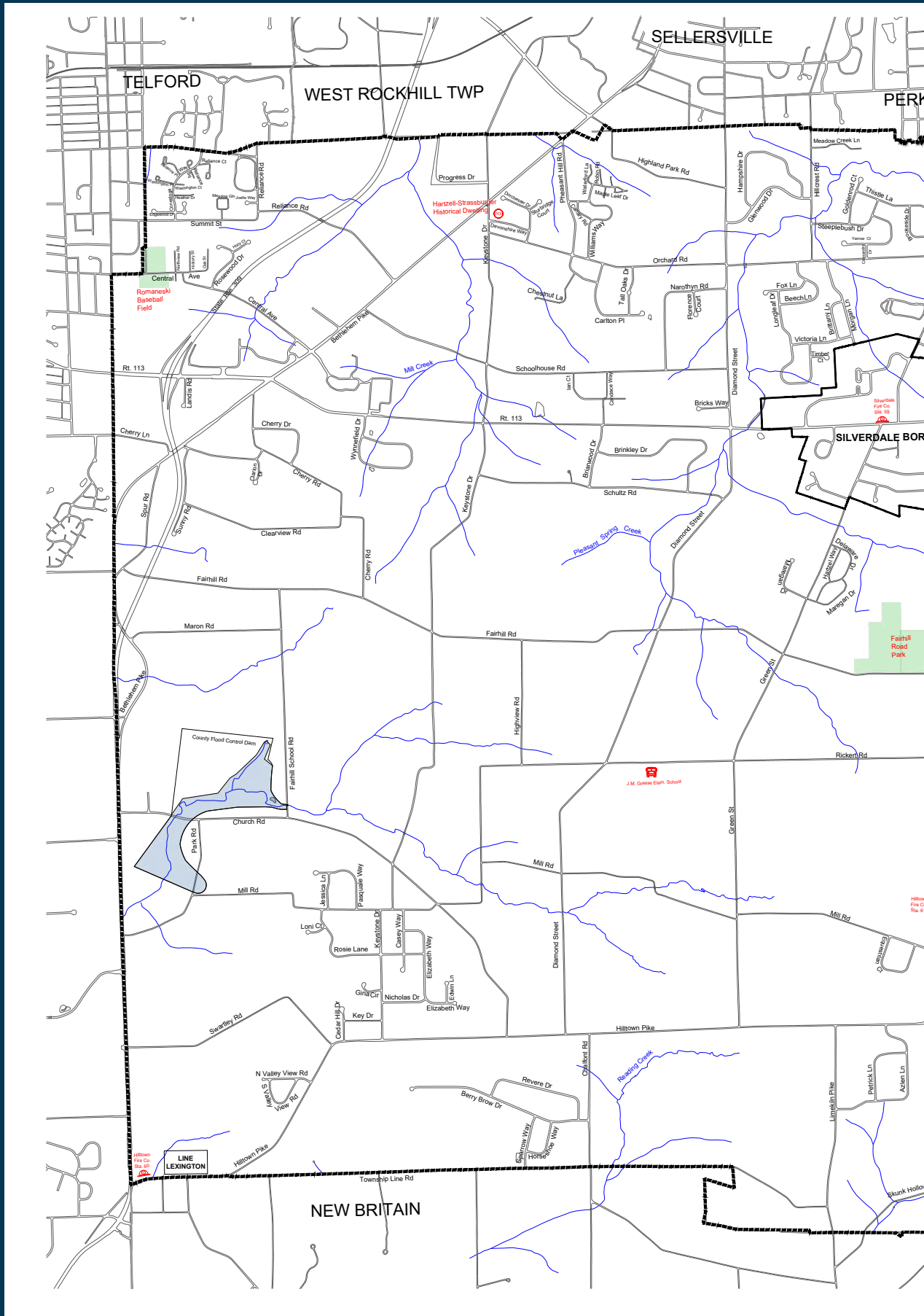

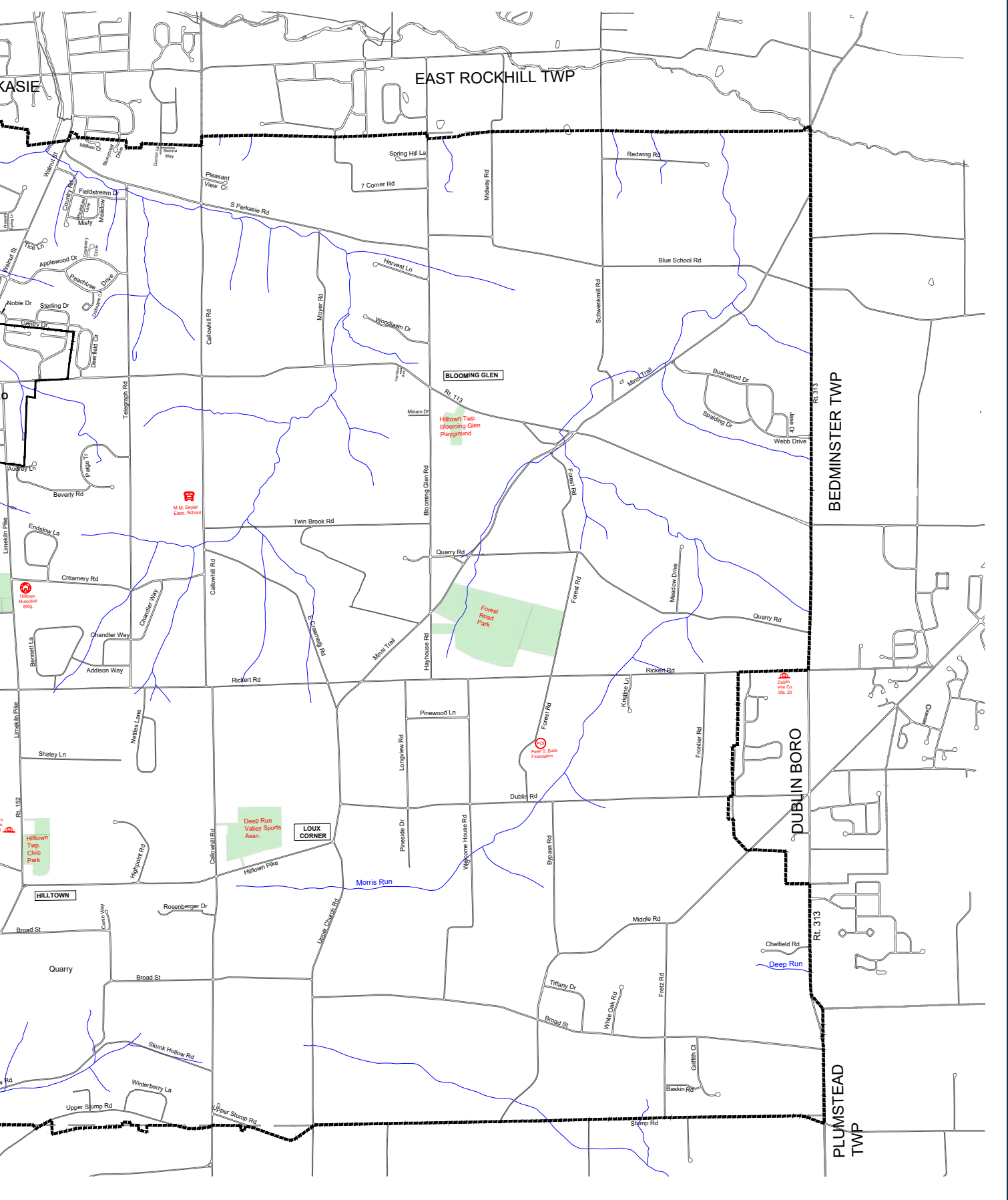

Hilltown Pike

Our high-speed highway that runs through Hilltown goes by the name of Hilltown Pike. In a quieter time, it was known as Minsi Trail. Minsi Trail was named after one of the tribes of the Lenape People. It ran from Philadelphia up to Bethlehem and was merely a section of Native American trails that ran throughout the east coast up into Canada. It was not much more than a path through the wilderness. The Europeans changed this. In May 1683, William Penn rode his horse up this trail to a preliminary land treaty negotiation with some Lenape Chiefs. Sassoonan, a young native boy who later became chief of the Lenape, attended this event, and later identified the spot where it took place. He said it was the first meeting place of William Penn and the Lenape chiefs. Sassoonan died in 1747. Research by John Pomphret, editor of the book "William Penn's Own Account of the Lenni Lenape or Delaware Indians". indicated this meeting occurred in Hilltown Township, in the village of Mount Pleasant (Crossroads Tavern) and the village of Hilltown. This area was once known as "Perkasie Indian Town", a 10,000-acre parcel of land William Penn had surveyed prior to development.

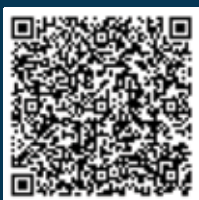
With the European immigration, the road we now call Hilltown Pike became part of what was once known as "The Great Road", or the "Bethlehem Road", sometimes the "Old Bethlehem Road". (Not to be confused with Bethlehem Pike!) It became the major road from Philadelphia to Bethlehem in Colonial times, complete with stagecoach stops throughout the township. It also provided transportation to the important Durham Iron Works. Toll houses were set up from Line Lexington to Route 313. The old Lenape path was widened to handle the wagons heading to and from Philadelphia.

SUMMER 2026

Stormwater runoff is rainwater that flows over lawns, driveways and streets, picking up pollutants along the way and carrying them straight into our waterways. This summer you can help to reduce stormwater runoff by following the tips below!

SUMMER STORMWATER TIPS FOR YOUR PROPERTY

- **Water Wisely:** Water lawns early in the morning or late evening to reduce water loss through evaporation. Avoid overwatering which can lead to runoff.
- **Use Fertilizers & Pesticides Sparingly:** Only apply when necessary and follow label instructions. Never apply before rain is expected!
- **Mow Smart:** Keep grass longer (3") to absorb more water. Leave clippings on the lawn as a natural fertilizer - never blow into streets or storm drains!
- **Wash Cars the Right Way:** Take your car to a commercial car wash where water is treated. If washing at home, do it on grass or gravel so water can soak in.
- **Try a Summer-Friendly Project:** Plant native flowers, shrubs or trees that soak up rain. Install a rain barrel to collect and reuse stormwater!

A Message from your Tax Collector, Diane Telly, CPTC

As we settle into the new year, the official schedule and payment guidelines for 2026 have been released. Whether you are a long-time resident or new to the area, keeping these dates on your radar can help you take advantage of early-payment discounts.

Mark Your Calendars: 2026 Deadlines

Property taxes are split into two distinct billing cycles. To receive the discounted rate, please note the following dates:

- County & Township Taxes: Bills are issued March 1. The deadline to pay at the discount rate is April 30.
- School Taxes: Bills are issued July 1. The deadline for the discount rate is August 31.

Modern & Traditional Payment Options

There are four ways to ensure your taxes are paid on time:

1. In Person: Visit the Hilltown Township Building. Specific dates and times for in-person collection are listed directly on your tax bill and at hilltowntaxcollect.wixsite.com/taxoffice.
2. Online: Payments can be made via the website above (please note that third-party processing fees apply).
3. Web-Banking: If you use your personal bank's "Bill Pay" feature, you must include your Parcel Number in the subject or memo line to ensure the payment is applied to the correct property.
4. USPS Mail: Payments can be sent to PO Box 265, Hilltown, PA 18927. A **Critical Note on Mailing!** The USPS has issued an important notice concerning postmarks. Standard mail processing is no longer a guaranteed proof of the date mailed. **Pro Tip:** If you are mailing your payment close to a deadline, do not simply drop it in a mailbox. Go to a USPS retail counter and ask a postal employee to "hand cancel" your stamp. This provides physical proof that your payment was sent before the deadline.
